DRAFT GUIDELIN<u>ES</u> FOR PREPARING THE EAST<u>ERN</u> ATLANTIC <u>AND</u> <u>MEDITERRANEAN</u> BLUEFIN TUNA FISHING, INSPECTION AND CAPACITY MANAGEMENT PLANS

Proposal submitted by Japan

In accordance with the *Recommendation by ICCAT Amending the Recommendation 13-07 by ICCAT to Establish a Multi-annual Recovery Plan for Bluefin Tuna in the Eastern Atlantic and Mediterranean* [Rec. 14-04], each Contracting Party and Cooperating non-Contracting Party, Entity or Fishing Entity (hereinafter referred to as CPC) which has <u>eastern</u> Atlantic <u>and Mediterranean bluefin tuna quota submits a fishing, inspection and capacity management plan. The Panel 2 (PA2) intersessional meeting reviews and endorses the submitted plans.</u>
