# DRAFT GUIDELINE FOR PREPARING THE EAST ATLANTIC BLUEFIN TUNA FISHING, INSPECTION AND CAPACITY MANAGEMENT PLANS

#### Proposal submitted by Japan

In accordance with the *Recommendation by ICCAT Amending the Recommendation 13-07 by ICCAT to Establish a Multi-annual Recovery Plan for Bluefin Tuna in the Eastern Atlantic and Mediterranean* [Rec. 14-04], each Contracting Party and Cooperating non-Contracting Party, Entity or Fishing Entity (hereinafter referred to as CPC) which has East Atlantic bluefin tuna quota submits fishing, inspection and capacity management plan. The Panel 2 (PA2) intersessional meeting reviews and endorses the submitted plans.

Each CPC is recommended to use the attached format (**Annex**) to prepare its East Atlantic bluefin tuna fishing, inspection and capacity management plan.
