

## IATTC Resolution on transshipments Key elements

- Resolution C-06-04 approved in 2006.
- Resolution C-08-02 replaced Res.C-06-04.
- Program effective as of January 1, 2009.
- Similar resolution to ICAAT and IOTC.
- Transshipments at port permitted under conditions specified in Annex 1.
- Transshipments at sea permitted in IATTC area only with observer on board on carrier vessel.
- Main responsibility of observers:

Monitor that the transshipped quantities are consistent with the catch reported in the IATTC transshipment declaration

### Other key elements of resolution C-08-02

- Vessels are prohibited from making transshipments in the EPO without an observer on board except in cases of *force majeure*.
- •Applies to Long line fishing vessels only.
- •Does not apply to troll vessels, pole-and-line vessels or vessels engaged in the transshipment of fresh fish at sea.
- Transfer of live tuna to be transported to a farm is not subject to this resolution.
- Establishes a register for carrier vessels authorized to receive transshipments at sea.
- Carrier vessels and the fishing vessels shall be equipped with a VMS.
- Transshipments within the EEZ are subject to authorization of the coastal State.
- Completing the IATTC *Transshipment Declaration* (TD) is obligatory for captains on the fishing vessel and carrier vessel.
- Copy should be sent to the Director of IATTC and to the competent authorities of the vessel's flag CPC and of the country where the final unloading will take place.

### Other key elements of resolution C-08-02

- •In validating any required statistical documents, the flag government shall ensure that the quantity of fish transshipped is consistent with the catches reported by the fishing vessel.
- •Each government shall inform the Director annually of the quantities transshipped the previous year, by species, and of the names of its vessels that made transshipments.
- •All transshipped tuna unloaded in, or imported into, the territory of a member shall be accompanied by the IATTC Declaration until the first sale takes place.
- •Costs of the observer program are borne by the flag governments of the fishing vessels involved. No observer is assigned to vessels whose flag government has not paid.

### Resolution C-08-02 added observer's tasks on the fishing vessel .

- Check the validity of the fishing vessel's authorization or license to fish.
- Check and record the total quantity of catch on board, and the quantity to be transferred to the carrier vessel;
- Check that the VMS is functioning, and examine the logbook;
- Verify whether any of the catch on board resulted from transfers from other vessels, and check the documentation on such transfers;
- In case of any violations involving the fishing vessel, report the violations to the master of the carrier vessel.
- Record the results in the observer's report.

To do these tasks, observers have to board the fishing vessel.

### **IATTC Resolution C-08-03**

- •Approved in 2008. It mandated a meeting of involved countries to determine the distribution of the cost of the program.
- Observer Program could be implemented by an external agency.
- •Marine Resources Assessment Group Ltd. (MRAG) Consortium, has implemented the IATTC Program under a contract since December, 2008.



# Possible future cooperation among RFMOs.

- Standardize transshipment rules.
- •Allow observers to collect transshipment data even when in another RFMO area.
- •Exchange data on transshipments made in the area of other RFMOs (WCPFC /EPO areas).
- •Allow vessels to transship on carrier vessels authorized by other RFMOs.
- Exchange transshipment data and compliance information.
