2020 SWO MSE TECHNICAL MEETING

Objectives

At the 2020 SCRS Swordfish Species Group meeting, a short term workplan was established for the Contractors together with the Modelers to finalize the reference set of Operating Models (OM), followed by a discussion to start testing Candidate Management Procedures (cMPs). The SWO Species Group requested another short interim meeting (in the form of a webinar) to further discuss any outstanding issues, depending on the progress with OM development. Given that a candidate OM grid is now complete, the meeting requested has been scheduled and is now announced. The objectives of this meeting are to update the current status of the OM development, update the status of the preliminary CMP development, update points of discussion for future meetings of the Commission (Panel 4) and prepare the workplan for the 2021 work.



In order to better organize the meetings, in 2014 the SCRS established deadlines for submitting documents, which were revised in 2015. These deadlines provide the rapporteurs with valuable information to better fit the meeting timetable as well as to allow the Secretariat to make the documents available to participants in advance of the meeting. In 2015 and 2019 the SCRS "proposed that a new deadline for the submission of SCRS documents and presentations should be implemented; these documents/presentations should be provided in their entirety at least one week before the meeting in which they are to be presented to facilitate their review by participating scientists prior to these meetings". Documents and presentations provided after the latter deadline will not be accepted unless previously authorized by the Chair. Authors are reminded to closely follow the *Guidelines for Authors of Scientific Documents for the ICCAT SCRS and Collective Volume Series*. Furthermore, the original documents (text, tables and figures) should be prepared in WORD or compatible software.
