2020 ICCAT SWORDFISH INTERSESSIONAL MEETING

(Madrid, Spain - 16-20 March 2020)

Objectives

In 2019 the SCRS elaborated a workplan for 2020 which included an intersessional meeting for the Swordfish Species Group, with the major focus on the progress of the swordfish biological and stock structure projects, and the development of the North Atlantic swordfish MSE process. The MSE work planned for 2020 is to finalize the conditioning of the Operating Model and to start testing alternative management procedures.

The SCRS also planned to conduct the next stock assessment for the Mediterranean stock in May 2020. Therefore, this meeting will address data preparatory issues related to Mediterranean swordfish in advance to the stock assessment meeting.

3. Language

4. Call for scientific papers

Participants are encouraged to submit relevant scientific papers. In order to better organize the meetings, in 2014 the SCRS established deadlines for submitting documents, which were revised in 2015. These deadlines provide the rapporteurs with valuable information to better fit the meeting timetable as well as allow the Secretariat to make the documents available to participants in advance of the meeting. In 2015 the SCRS "proposed that a new deadline for the submission of SCRS documents should be implemented; these documents should be provided in their entirety at least one week before the meeting in which they are to be presented to facilitate their review by participating scientists prior to these meetings". As such the full documents for this meeting should be provided to info@iccat.int or miguel.santos@iccat.int by 9 March 2020. Authors are reminded to closely follow the Guidelines for Authors of Scientific Documents for the ICCAT SCRS and Collective Volume Series. Furthermore, the original documents (text, tables and figures) should be prepared in WORD or compatible software.

5. Funding

Funding is available to cover travel and subsistence expenses for a scientist from each ICCAT developing Contracting Party who can provide information relevant to the meeting objectives, particularly in reference to provision of data.
