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#### Workshop of the Swordfish Year Programme (SWOYP)

(Hybrid/Olhão (Portugal), 27 to 29 February 2024)

The Swordfish Year Programme (SWOYP) was established by the ICCAT Swordfish Species Group in 2018 to support biological research important for the assessment and management of the three ICCAT managed swordfish stocks. The objectives of this workshop are to i) review the progress of the SWOYP to date; ii) identify improvements needed within the programme; and iii) plan priority research areas for future project phases. Special emphasis will be placed on development of studies that address uncertainties important in the stock assessment and Management Strategy Evaluation (MSE) and, in particular, work on understanding effects of Climate Change on stock distribution and biology. The outputs of this workshop will be incorporated in the SCRS Strategic Research Plan currently in development.
