**Albacore Data Preparatory Meeting**  
*(hybrid, Pasaia, Spain, 13-17 April 2026)*

**Objectives**

The main objectives for 2026 are to conduct a full stock assessment for South Atlantic albacore and develop the Management Strategy Evaluation (MSE) framework for this stock, to iterate the current MP for the North Atlantic albacore and test alternative new MPs under the new MSE framework, to apply the exceptional circumstances protocol (ECP) of the northern stock, and to continue with the research as defined in the Albacore Year Programme (ALBYP).

The main objective of this meeting is to prepare the data for the southern full stock assessment which will serve as the basis for the development of the south Atlantic ALB MSE. As for the northern stock, the data required to iterate the MP (which requires running a production model) and the development of the new MSE will be revised. In addition, some exceptional circumstances will be checked and the Albacore Year Programme (ALBYP) will be discussed.

### 3. Language

Following the recommendations from the SCRS and the decision of the Commission in 2025, language interpretation will not be provided during the meeting.

### 4. Call for scientific papers and presentations

Participants are encouraged to submit relevant scientific papers. In advance of submitting those, authors shall request the SCRS reference from the meeting Chair, Haritz Arrizabalaga and the ICCAT Secretariat contact. After clearance from the meeting Chair, the ICCAT Secretariat will assign a specific SCRS reference and inform the author(s).

Following the latest SCRS deadlines for the submission of SCRS documents and presentations, for this meeting, these should be sent to [info@iccat.int](mailto:info@iccat.int) and/or [mauricio.ortiz@iccat.int](mailto:mauricio.ortiz@iccat.int) by **6 April 2026**. Documents and presentations provided after the deadline will not be accepted unless previously authorized by the Chair. Authors are reminded to closely follow the new *Guidelines for Authors of Scientific Documents for the ICCAT SCRS and Collective Volume Series*. Furthermore, the original documents (text, tables, and figures) should be prepared in WORD or compatible software.

### 5. Provision of data

CPCs are requested to submit updates of Task 1 and Task 2 data already reported (up to the year 2024) at least two weeks before the start of the meeting (**29 March 2026**).

Individual standardized catch per unit effort (CPUE) indices until 2024 should be provided for the northern and southern Atlantic stocks. Since the Working Group on Stock Assessment Methods (WGSAM) established standard criteria to evaluate standardized catch rates, it is recommended that authors of documents on standardized CPUEs follow the instructions defined by the WGSAM, describing the information required to facilitate the appropriate construction and evaluation of CPUE series.



## 6. Registration

Participants are kindly requested to register for the meeting by **30 March 2026** at the latest. Early registration is essential for the ICCAT Secretariat to ensure the setting up of the online platform. **Online registration** must be completed through the [ICCAT meetings webpage](#) or the Registration form. All delegates from CPCs wishing to attend the meeting must notify in advance their Head Delegate or Head Scientist to ensure that they are included in the official list that must be sent to the ICCAT Secretariat by **30 March 2026**.
