DRAFT PROPOSAL FOR A RECOMMENDATION BY ICCAT TO SUPPLEMENT RECOMMENDATION [16-01] BY ICCAT ON A MULTI-ANNUAL CONSERVATION AND MANAGEMENT PROGRAMME FOR TROPICAL TUNAS

Submitted by the European Union

RECALLING the current multi-annual conservation and management programme for tropical tunas;

NOTING that the stock of bigeye tuna is currently overfished;

TAKING INTO ACCOUNT the recommendations made by the Panel on the Second ICCAT Performance Review regarding the carryover of underage of catches from one year to another;

NOTING the absence of explicit management objectives for tropical tunas:

ALSO TAKING INTO ACCOUNT that in 2018 Bigeye tuna will be subject to a stock assessment and that the SCRS is also expected to provide the Commission with definitions concerning Fisheries Aggregating Devices (FADs):

THE INTERNATIONAL COMMISSION FOR THE CONSERVATION OF ATLANTIC TUNAS (ICCAT) RECOMMENDS THAT:

- 1. For both bigeye tuna and yellowfin tuna, the <u>carryover of</u> underage o<u>f</u> annual catch limits from previous years shall <u>be set at a maximum of 15% in 2018 and 10% in 2019 and thereafter.</u>
- 2. Panel 1 shall convene an intersessional meeting in 2018, in order to:
 - a. <u>Identify management objectives for the tropical tuna fisheries;</u>
 - b. Evaluate different management options for purse seine fisheries:
 - 1) Limitation of capacity
 - 2) Catch limits
 - 3) Closures: temporal and time-area closures
 - 4) Number of FAD-associated sets
 - 5) Number of FADs
 - 6) <u>Use of support vessels</u>
 - 7) Other measures to reduce FADs related mortality of small BET and YFT
 - c. Evaluate different management options for longline fisheries:
 - 1) Limitation of the capacity
 - 2) Catch limits

3) Transhipment at sea

d. Identify:

- 1) Management options for other gears
- 2) Expected impacts on MSY and stock status of different gear catch contribution
- 3) <u>Mechanisms to ensure effective implementation of the tropical tuna management measures</u>
- 4) MSE for tropical tunas
 - a. Individual vs. multi stocks
 - b. Schedule of implementation
 - c. $\underline{Performance\ metrics\ for\ the\ tropical\ tuna\ MSE}$
- 5) Workplan to address the Recommendations of the Ad Hoc Working Group on FADs
