JOINT STATEMENT OF THE KINGDOM OF MOROCCO, COTE D'IVOIRE, SENEGAL, GABON, SAO TOME AND PRINCIPE, GUINEA (REP.) REGARDING THE DRAFT AMENDMENT TO THE ICCAT CONVENTION – DOCUMENT PLE-137/2017

- 1. The Kingdom of Morocco, Côte d'Ivoire, Senegal, Gabon, Sao Tomé and Príncipe and Guinea (Rep.) reject the drafting of the text of document PLE-137/2017 which does not address their concerns.
- 2. The countries call on the Commission to adopt a decision based on Annex II of the Convention, clearly stating that Chinese Taipei is the sole fishing entity which could be eligible for admission to ICCAT.
- 3. The potential entry of any other fishing entity must achieve the (unanimous) consensus of the members of the Commission.
