***Supplementary note at 7 Dec 2017:** In October 2015, at the request of TCC11 the Executive Director sent letters to: Chinese Taipei and Georgia to request information of their vessel/s on the WCPFC IUU list, specifically their last known operations and whereabouts; and to other RFMOs (CCAMLR, CCSBT, IATTC, ICCAT, IOTC, NPAFC & SPRFMO) to seek their cooperation with locating the vessels on the WCPFC IUU list underlining that they are now listed on a number of IUU lists. Georgia replied to confirm that the vessels Neptune and Fu Lien No 1 are no longer flying Georgia flag. Chinese Taipei confirmed that with respect to Yu Fong 168, the license was revoked in 2009 the owner of the vessel has been penalized through repeated monetary punishment for violating the rules of not returning to port. Chinese Taipei further advised that the most recent information was received from Thailand's notification to IOTC that the vessel landed their catches in the port of Phuket in the year 2013. On 17 November 2017, WCPFC received a communication from Chinese Taipei informing WCPFC that Yu Fong 168 has been deregistered by Chinese Taipei.

The Secretariat received input from Chinese Taipei who informed that the vessel YU FONG 168 was not flagged to Chinese Taipei. This change was presented in the Draft ICCAT IUU list (Circular n° 568/18 of 14 August 2018).

In July 2018, Bolivia has informed the ICCAT Secretariat that the vessel *KIM SENG DENG 3* is not registered under Bolivian flag (as explained in **Appendix 1**). This change was presented in the Draft ICCAT IUU list (Circular n° 568/18 of 14 August 2018).

In September 2018, Bolivia has informed the Secretariat that the vessels *ABUNDANT 1*, *ABUNDANT 12*, *ABUNDANT 3*, *ABUNDANT 6*, *ABUNDANT 9*, *SHENG JI QUN 3*, *SHUN LAI*, *YUTUNA 3* and *YUTUNA NO.1* that are listed under “unknown flag” have call sign numbers starting by **CPA-XXX** which correspond, erroneously, to the Bolivian flag (refer to **Appendix 2**). In addition, in October 2018, Bolivia reiterated its request to delist the vessels mentioned in Appendix 1 and 2 (as informed in **Appendix 3**). Since the vessels were listed by IOTC, in October 2018 Bolivia has also sent a request to IOTC to have the vessels quoted above delisted (refer to **Appendix 4**).

In time, to express my cordial greetings and wish you every success in your work, I have the honour to address your Authority regarding ICCAT Circular #5681/18, #6509/17, IOTC Circular #5731/2018 and IOTC Recommendation 11-18 (IUU list), regarding the ICCAT draft list of IUU vessels, where alleged vessels flying Bolivian flag contravened IOTC Resolution 11-03. In this regard, the Plurinational State of Bolivia, through the Maritime Authorities, reviewed the data base of the Bolivian International Vessel Register, and it was noted that the vessels that are included in the draft list of IUU vessels, are not and were not registered under Bolivian flag or with a fishing license of the Plurinational State of Bolivia. These are detailed below:-

Regarding the radio call sign used by illegal fishing vessels, please note that the Bolivian code includes three letter digits (CPA) and four numbers, therefore, the radio call signs of those vessels do not correspond to Bolivia.

Moreover, we would like to inform the Commission that on 11 and 13 September 2017 and 3 July 2018, documents related to this issue were transmitted to ICCAT and are attached herein.

Likewise, we would like to inform that Bolivia, through the Maritime Authorities together with a commission of the Kingdom of Thailand, conducted an investigation in 2017 of the aforementioned vessels as they were flying a Bolivian flag, carried certificates of the Bolivian vessel register and were found conducting illegal fishing in the economic exclusive zone of the Kingdom of Thailand. The results of the investigation showed that the vessels were carrying documents that had not been issued by the Bolivian Maritime Authorities and had been forged by the vessel owners. Thus, the Kingdom of Thailand determined to confiscate the vessels.

On the other hand, in the name of the Plurinational State of Bolivia and aimed at maintaining its impeccable image, I would like to request the governing board of ICCAT and IOTC to delist Bolivia from the list of vessels related to illegal fishing, as they are not registered under the Plurinational State of Bolivia.

Thus, reiterating the commitment of this Maritime Administration in fighting against illegal, unreported and unregulated fishing (IUU) and complying with the regulations of the Commission.

For this purpose, I take this opportunity to reiterate, Mr. Executive Secretary, the assurances of my highest and most distinguished consideration.






In time, to express my cordial greetings and wish you every success in your work, I have the honour to address your Authority regarding ICCAT Circular #5731/18, IOTC Recommendation 11-18 (IUU list), ICCAT Circular #6509/2017 regarding the ICCAT draft list of IOTC vessels, where alleged vessels flying Bolivian flag contravened IOTC Resolution 11-03. In this regard, the Plurinational State of Bolivia, through the Maritime Authorities, reviewed the data base of the Bolivian International Vessel Register, and it was noted that the vessels that are included in the draft list of IUU vessels, are not and were not registered under Bolivian flag or with a fishing license of the Plurinational State of Bolivia. These are detailed below:-

Regarding the radio call sign used by illegal fishing vessels, please note that the Bolivian code includes three letter digits (CPA) and four numbers, therefore, the radio call signs of those vessels do not correspond to Bolivia.

Moreover, we would like to inform the Commission that on 11 and 13 September 2017 and 3 July 2018, documents related to this issue were transmitted to ICCAT and are attached herein.

Likewise, we would like to inform that Bolivia, through the Maritime Authorities together with a commission of the Kingdom of Thailand, conducted an investigation in 2017 of the aforementioned vessels as they were flying a Bolivian flag, carried certificates of the Bolivian vessel register and were found conducting illegal fishing in the economic exclusive zone of the Kingdom of Thailand. The results of the investigation showed that the vessels were carrying documents that had not been issued by the Bolivian Maritime Authorities and had been forged by the vessel owners. Thus, the Kingdom of Thailand determined to confiscate the vessels.

On the other hand, in the name of the Plurinational State of Bolivia and aimed at maintaining its impeccable image, I would like to request the governing board of ICCAT and IOTC to delist Bolivia from the list of vessels related to illegal fishing, as they are not registered under the Plurinational State of Bolivia.

Thus, reiterating the commitment of this Maritime Administration in fighting against illegal, unreported and unregulated fishing (IUU) and complying with the regulations of the Commission.

For this purpose, I take this opportunity to reiterate, Mr. Executive Secretary, the assurances of my highest and most distinguished consideration.
