**STREAMLINING OF ICCAT CONSERVATION AND MANAGEMENT MEASURES**

**Measures for consideration by PWG**

*ICCAT Secretariat, in consultation with Chairs of subsidiary bodies*

**PWG**

1. At the 11<sup>th</sup> meeting of the IMM Working Group, Sapporo, July 2016, it was agreed to update and to combine ICCAT measures from:

[94-09] *Resolution by ICCAT on compliance with the ICCAT conservation and management measures (including Addendum)*

And

[97-11] *Recommendation by ICCAT on transshipments and vessel sightings*

The IMM Working Group considered this issue and has tabled a proposed combined contained in PWG\_408/2019.

**Suggested action:** PWG\_408/2019 to be considered and adopted if acceptable.

The following two issues were agreed by IMM in 2018, but it was not clear from the 2018 Commission report if the Commission had agreed. Unless there are any objections, the Secretariat will remove Recs. 09-09 and 12-09 from the forthcoming 2020 Compendium.

2. [09-09] *Recommendation by ICCAT Amending three recommendations in Conformity with the 2009 Recommendation by ICCAT Concerning the Establishment of an ICCAT Record of Vessels 20 Metres in Length Overall or Greater authorized to Operate in the Convention Area*

In previous years the issues of incorporating the amendments of Rec. 09-09 into the amended measures or subsequent measures replacing the amended measures to remove Rec. 09-09 from the active Compendium had been considered, but no conclusion reached. As no clear guidance was given by the Commission on the issue last year, Footnotes have been added in the Active Compendium, but Rec. 09-09 has been left active pending specific instruction.

**Suggested action:** Remove Rec. 09-09 from the Compendium.

3. [12-09] *Recommendation by ICCAT on a Process towards the Establishment of a Catch Certification Scheme for Tuna and Tuna-Like Species*

As currently written, this Recommendation calls for a series of actions within timelines which have already passed.
