## MEETING PARTICIPATION FUND<sup>1</sup>

In 2014 the Commission adopted the *Recommendation by ICCAT Amending the Recommendation 11-26 on the Establishment of a Meeting Participation Fund for Developing ICCAT Contracting Parties* (Rec. 14-14) which substitutes and repeals Rec. 11-26 in its entirety.

Recommendation 14-14 establishes a Meeting Participation Fund (MPF) to support representatives of those ICCAT Contracting Parties which are developing States for the purpose of attending and/or contributing to the work of the Commission and other subsidiary bodies. This fund was initially provisioned with €60,000.00 from the Working Capital Fund.

The new recommendation differs from the previous one in that participation of two members per delegation (a manager and a scientist) will be financed for SWGSM meetings only, and for the remainder of meetings one member per delegation will be financed.

This fund was financed in 2019 with an allocation of €72,000.00 charged to Chapter 13b) of the ICCAT budget, as approved by the Commission in 2018. In addition, the Secretariat has received voluntary contributions from the United States (€57,087.65), from Canada (€75,000.00) and from the European Union, through the European Union Fund for Capacity Building (€28,000.00).

To these funds, the carryover of financial year 2018 must be added, which amounted to €51,381.75. Therefore, the available amount in 2019 has been €283,469.40.

Implementation of this fund has significantly driven participation by representatives of developing Contracting Parties, so much so that this year 105 trips have been organised and 30 CPCs have benefited.

In 2017, the Commission approved the inclusion in the budget of an item to finance the expenses of this fund. The contribution from the 2019 budget has been €72,000.00 and therefore insufficient to cover all costs, but as the Commission decided, this item will be gradually regularised so that in 2021 all annual costs can be covered. Until that time, it will be necessary for CPCs to make voluntary contributions so that all requests can be covered.

Taking into account the number of requests for participation in meetings, and therefore, the expense incurred and charged to this fund, it is estimated that for 2020 it is necessary to allocate some €320,000.00. This amount will be allocated from the 2019 carryover (€20,000.00), charged to Chapter 13.a) of the ICCAT budget (€200,000.00), and through the funds provided under the contract with the European Union that is pending formalization.

Given the number of requests and meetings that will be held in 2020, as in 2019, even if fully completed requests are submitted by the established deadlines and even where they have been pre-approved, the Secretariat will only guarantee financing of travel if the Meeting Participation Fund has available funds. A circular will be sent to CPCs twice a year informing of the balance.

Contracting Parties and Cooperating non-Contracting Parties, Entities or Fishing Entities are requested to inform STACFAD and the Executive Secretary of the amounts which they could commit to the MPF through voluntary contributions for 2020.

Finally, it is recalled that access to the funds for participation in meetings is governed by a protocol published on the web site and sent to the delegations for each of the meetings. The requests received are submitted for approval to the ICCAT Chairman and the STACFAD Chair.
